UNDERGRADUATE ADMISSION INFORMATION / GUIDELINES

1. Implementing Choice-Based Credit System

The new educational policy, at par with international standards, is geared toward bringing equity, efficiency and academic excellence with special emphasis on innovation and improvement in curriculum design, a paradigm shift in learning and teaching pedagogy, and revamped examination and grading patterns. This system is described as “learner-centric” with a “cafeteria approach” allowing a student to choose course from a wide range of disciplines, intra-disciplinary as well as interdisciplinary, depending on the student’s interest in the subject(s) and career choice. In other words, the system offers opportunities to explore additional avenues of learning for holistic development while pursuing specialisation in the chosen subject of studies. Keeping in view of the overall benefits that would accrue to the students, Patkai is implementing the new UGC recommended system with committed enthusiasm and confidence.

3. COURSES OFFERED AND ELIGIBILITY:

- 3.1 A minimum of 45% marks in the concerned subject in the HSSLC is required for honours admission in **Education, Economics, History, Philosophy, Commerce, Botany, Chemistry, Mathematics, Zoology, Physics**; 50% in **Political Science** for honours admission in Political Science; 55% in English for honours admission in English; 45% in Science for honours admission in **Geology and Computer Science**; and minimum aggregate percentage in any stream required for **BCA** admission is 40%, and 45% in any subject for honours admission in **Mass Communication**.
- 3.2 Applicants opting for Physics and Computer Science honours must have cleared Mathematics in the HSSLC.
- 3.3 Applicants must have a minimum of 40% in aggregate. There’s no entertainment of any candidate with any standards less than what’s prescribed here.
- 3.4 Applicants may apply for admission for a subject not taken in the HSSLC provided their minimum aggregate percentage satisfies the prescribed percentage for each subject indicated in the above (3.1).
- 3.5 To arrive at clarity in respect to any doubts, applicants are advised to ask for help from Admission Director before finalising admission process.

4. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR ADMISSION:

- 4.1 Photocopies of Admit Card, Mark sheet of HSLC and HSSLC, Original Transfer Certificate, three recent colour passport photos of 3 × 3.5 size with white background. Write your full name on the back of each photo copy.
- 4.2 Migration Certificate and Eligibility Certificate (for candidates from boards other than NBSE)
- 4.3 At the time of Admission, produce original documents at admission time for verification

5. N.B

- 5.1 - Candidate’s own presence shall be required for guidance and counselling for admission.
- 5.2 - Admission into undergraduate classes is done Semester wise. Detail information is given in the prospectus.
- 5.3 - Admission for all categories is done on first come first serve basis both for UG and PG.
- 5.4 - Patkai has opted for Honours programme only for UG level.
- 5.5 - Information for dates of arrival and commencement of classes will be communicated at admission time or as provided in the prospectus.

COURSES OFFERED AND ELIGIBILITY:

English	50% in English Honours (General Category) 45% in English Honours (ST/SC/OBC)
Political Science	50% in Political Science Honours (General Category). 45% in Political Science Honours (ST/SC/OBC) 50% in Aggregate in BA General/ other Honours
Environmental Science	55% in any Science subject (General Category) 50% in any Science subject (ST/SC/OBC)
Geology	55% in Geology Honours (General Category) 50% in Geology Honours (ST/SC/OBC)

Nota Bene

1.1 Non-English Honours students whose minimum aggregate percentage in English papers is 55% may also apply for admission to M.A. in English. However, admission to such applicants may be granted only against vacancy created in the sanctioned number of seats.

1.2 CBCS candidates should have English as Generic in all the four semesters with an aggregate of 55%.

2.1 Non-Political Science Honours students whose minimum aggregate percentage in Political Science papers is 50% may also apply for admission.

2.2 CBCS candidates should have Political Science as Generic in all the four semesters with an aggregate of 50%.

3.1 Non-Geology Honours students with Geology as Elective Papers at under-graduate level may also apply for admission to M. Sc. in Geology. Admission to such applicants will be based on written test/interview to be conducted by the Department of Geology.

3.2 CBCS candidates should have Geology as Generic in all the four semesters with an aggregate of 55%.

4.1 Candidate's presence is mandatory at the time of admission.

5. Documents Required

1. Photo copies of Admit Cards and Marksheets from HSLC onward.
2. Passed certificates from HSLC onwards.
3. Original Transfer Certificate.
4. Three recent colour passport photos (3.5x3.5) with white back ground.
5. Migration Certificate (for candidates from university other than Nagaland University).
6. All the **original documents** have to be produced at the time of admission for verification.
