REPORT ON A ONE DAY WEBINAR ON NEP 2020: FEATURES AND PROSPECTS

A brief report of the webinar organised by the Department of Education, Patkai Christian College (Autonomous) on 7th November 2020 on the theme, “NEP, 2020: Features and Prospects”

A one-day webinar was organised by the Department of Education, Patkai Christian College (Autonomous), Chümoukedima-Seithekema on 7th November 2020 on the theme NEP, 2020: Features and Prospects. The resource persons were Prof. Harjeet Kaur Bhatia, Department of Educational Studies, Jamia Milia Islamia, New Delhi and Prof. Buno Liegise, Department of Education, Nagaland University.

At the outset, the welcome note was given by Mrs. Neilevono Vüprü, HoD, Department of Education, Patkai Christian College. In the brief speech, she welcomed the Resource Persons, the Principal, the Vice Principal, the Deans, the IQAC members and the staff and faculties present as participants.

The opening remark was given by the Principal of the college, Dr. T. Pierü. In his remarks, he pointed out how the UGC and Ministry of Education has been preparing the people by conducting a series of National conclave on transformational reform in higher education, Governors’ conference, visitors’ conference and others. Higher Education department of Nagaland had directed the colleges and universities in the state to organise webinars on issues related to awareness and implementation of NEP, 2020. This webinar is a fulfilment of the directive of the Higher Education Department of the state.

The moderator of the webinar was Mrs. Razoukhrülü Kehie. After introduction of the Resource Person, she gave time for the first technical session which was taken by Prof. Harjeet Kaur Bhatia who spoke on the topic, “NEP, 2020: The Road ahead”. In reference to the topic, she spoke about the shifting of education from factory model of education to development of students’ potentials. NEP aims to facilitate an inclusive, participatory and holistic approach, which takes into consideration field experiences, empirical research, stakeholder feedback as well as lessons learned from best practices. She stated the vision of NEP, 2020 as an education system that contributes to an equitable and vibrant knowledge society, by providing high quality education to all. Education is to develop a deep sense of respect towards the fundamental rights, duties and constitutional values, bonding with one’s country and a conscious awareness of one’s role and responsibilities in a changing world. Education also should instil skills, values and dispositions that support responsible commitment to human rights, sustainable development and living and global well-being thereby reflecting a truly global citizen. She also emphasised on the use of technology as

taken a front seat and seeing it as a panacea. There has been a tectonic shift in the use of technology eg. Mobile was once prohibited, now school is in mobile.

The second Resource Person, Prof. Buno Liegise spoke on “Fresh Perspectives of Higher Education in NEP, 2020: Challenges and Opportunities”. A new comprehensive policy on education was introduced in India after 34 years with the last National Policy of Education implemented in 1986 which was reviewed in 1992. A huge paradigm shift can be expected at the higher level of education as and when the NEP, 2020 got implemented in the near future. There will be three types of universities – Research Intensive Universities, Teaching Intensive Universities and Autonomous Degree Granting Universities. There will be no more affiliation of colleges to universities unless the colleges are not strong enough to keep themselves afloat. NEP 2020 is set to bring drastic changes in higher education system in India where students can enjoy flexible education options such as three year or four year Bachelors degree, one year Master’s degree, exit options and multidisciplinary education. She also spoke on the challenges of implementation of the policy in a multi-culture and multi-lingual society like Nagaland where there is no common language which can be addressed as mother tongue whereas NEP 2020 emphasised mother tongue to be the medium of instruction at the lower level of education. Multiple entry and exit at the higher level can also cause mayhem especially in the exam section in view of keeping track of the students where students can take advantage of the situation, lowering the quality of education. She expressed hope that just as NPE, 1986 was reviewed in 1992. There could be some revision before the actual implementation of the policy.

The webinar ended with a vote of thanks pronounced by Mr. Kaisü Losa. She first thanked God Almighty, the Resource Persons, the men behind the program, who made the webinar materialised and the participants.
