  - Those Candidates given provisional admission before their result declaration and subsequently failing to qualify/ meet the eligibility criteria, all fees paid will be reimbursed fully. However, for candidates whose admission status are confirmed and wishing to withdraw their admission for different reasons, the college refunding rules will be applied.

## Master of Arts in English

### Admission Eligibility

- 50% in English Honours (General Category)
- 45% in English Honours (ST/SC/OBC)

### Nota Bene:

- *CBCS candidates should have English as Generic in all the four semesters with an aggregate of 55%.*
- *Non-English Honours students whose minimum aggregate percentage in English papers is 55% may also apply for admission to M.A. in English. However, admission to such applicants may be granted only against vacancy created in the sanctioned number of seats. For further information contact Admission Director.*

## Master of Arts in Political Science

### Admission Eligibility

- 50% in Political Science Honours (General Category)
- 45% in Political Science Honours (ST/SC/OBC)
- 50% in Aggregate in BA General/ other Honours

### Nota Bene:

*CBCS candidates applying for MA in Political Science should have Political Science as Generic in all the four semesters with an aggregate of 50%.*

## Master of Science in Botany

### Admission Eligibility

- For 2 years M.Sc in Botany:  
-B.Sc in Botany honours with minimum of 60%

## Master of Science in Environmental Science

### Admission Eligibility

- 55% in any Science subject (General Category)
- 50% in any Science subject (ST/SC/OBC)

## Master of Science in Geology

### Admission Eligibility

- 55% in Geology Honours (General Category)
- 50% in Geology Honours (ST/SC/OBC)

### Nota Bene:

*Non-Geology Honours candidates who have Geology as Generic (24 credits) or as Elective Paper with an aggregate of 55% may also apply. However, there will be personal interview for such candidates. For details contact Admission Director.*

## Master of Science in Physics

### Admission Eligibility

- For 2 years M.Sc in Physics:  
-B.Sc in Physics honours with minimum of 50%

## Master of Science in Zoology

### Admission Eligibility

- For 2 years M.Sc in Zoology:
  - B.Sc in Zoology honours with minimum of 60%

## Bachelor of Arts (B. A.)

### Admission Eligibility

#### Core courses (Honours courses)

1.	Education	:	45 % in Education

3.	English	:	50 % in English

#### Nota Bene:

- *Applicants over all aggregate must be 40% and above*
- *Applicants may apply for core course in the subject not taken in HSSLC provided their minimum aggregate percentage is equal to or more than the prescribed percentage for each subject indicated above.*
- *Generic Electives (GE) are compulsory courses to be co-opted along with the core (honours) courses. The GE course is from another discipline other than the honours discipline. Wide-ranging inter-disciplinary courses are offered as generic electives for students to choose based on their career choice and interest. All the generic elective courses are of six credits each and are mandatory for all honours students to take one course in each of the first four semesters. It is for the student to choose GE from the same discipline in all the four semesters; or go from one discipline to the other after every semester.*
- *Generic Elective Course Options for Arts students: From any discipline in Arts, Commerce, Science (with Science background in class XII), Computer Science and Mass communication.*

# Bachelor of Science

## Admission Eligibility

### Core course (Subjects)

1. Botany : 45 % in Biology
  2. Chemistry : 45 % in Chemistry
  3. Geology : 45 % aggregate in Science
  4. Mathematics : 45 % in Mathematics
  5. Physics : 45 % in Physics with Mathematics passed in HSSLC
  6. Zoology : 45 % in Biology
7. For 5 years integrated M.Sc in Botany:  
-Higher Secondary (Science) with minimum of 45% in Biology.
8. For 5 years integrated in M.Sc in Physics  
-Higher Secondary (Science) with minimum 45% in Physics & pass in mathematics.
9. For 5 years integrated M.Sc in Zoology:  
-Higher Secondary (Science) with minimum 45% in Zoology.

### Nota Bene:

- *Applicants over all aggregate must be 40% and above*
- *All applicants must opt for one core course and one generic elective*
- *Applicants for **Geology** and **Computer Science** as core paper must have at least **45% in aggregate in HSSLC (Science)***
- *Applicants opting for Computer Science and Physics as core course must clear Mathematics paper in HSSLC.*
- *Generic Electives (GE) are compulsory courses to be co-opted along with the core (honours) courses. The GE course is from another discipline other than the honours discipline Wide-ranging inter-disciplinary courses are offered as generic electives for students to choose based on their career choice and interest. All the generic elective courses are of six credits each and are mandatory for all honours students to take one course in each of the first four semesters. It is for the student to choose GE from the same discipline in all the four semesters; or go from one discipline to the other after every semester.*
- *Generic Elective Course Options for Science students: From any discipline in Arts, Commerce, Science, Computer Science and Mass communication.*

# Bachelor of Commerce

## Admission Eligibility

- *Core course offered: Accountancy*
- *Applicants must have 45% in Accountancy*
- *Applicants over all aggregate must be 40% and above*
  
- *Generic Electives (GE) are compulsory courses to be co-opted along with the core (honours) courses. The GE course is from another discipline other than the honours discipline Wide-ranging inter-disciplinary courses are offered as generic electives for students to choose based on their career choice and interest. All the generic elective courses are of six credits each and are mandatory for all honours students to take one course in each of the first four semesters. It is for the student to choose GE from the same discipline in all the four semesters; or go from one discipline to the other after every semester.*
- *Generic Elective Course Options for Commerce students: From any discipline from Arts, Commerce, Science (apart from Mathematics for other science generic course a candidate should have Science background in class XII), Computer Science and Mass Communication*

# Bachelor of Computer Applications

## Admission Eligibility

Minimum percentage for admission to BCA is 40% aggregate in HSSLC in any stream.

### *Generic Elective:*

*Generic Electives (GE) are compulsory courses to be co-opted along with the core (honours) courses. The GE course is from another discipline other than the honours discipline Wide-ranging inter-disciplinary courses are offered as generic electives for students to choose based on their career choice and interest. All the generic elective courses are of six credits each and are mandatory for all honours students to take one course in each of the first four semesters. It is for the student to choose GE from the same discipline in all the four semesters; or go from one discipline to the other after every semester.*

*Generic Elective Course Options for BCA students: From any discipline in Commerce and Computer Science*

## **B. Voc. Degree in Multimedia and Mass Communication**

### **Admission Eligibility**

Minimum percentage for admission to Mass Communication is 45% aggregate in HSSLC in any stream.

#### ***Generic Elective:***

*Generic Electives (GE) are compulsory courses to be co-opted along with the core (honours) courses. The GE course is from another discipline other than the honours discipline. Wide-ranging inter-disciplinary courses are offered as generic electives for students to choose based on their career choice and interest. All the generic elective courses are of six credits each and are mandatory for all honours students to take one course in each of the first four semesters. It is for the student to choose GE from the same discipline in all the four semesters; or go from one discipline to the other after every semester.*

*Generic Elective Course Options for Multimedia and mass communication students: From any discipline in Arts, Commerce, Science (with Science background in class XII), and Computer Science.*

## **Bachelor of Music**

### **Admission Eligibility**

- Application forms for B. Mus. is to be filled in only after passing the music audition.
- Admission is based purely on the Entrance Test/Audition merit list as determined by the Music Department of the college.
- Minimum aggregate percentage in HSSLC (any stream) is 40%. However, applicants with UG Degree need not necessarily have minimum of 40% in HSSLC
- Successful applicants in Diploma of Music from MSSM are also relaxed from the minimum requirement of 40% at class XII level.

## **Diploma in Music**

### **Admission Eligibility**

- Application forms for Diploma in Music is to be filled in only after passing the music audition.
- Admission is based purely on the Entrance Test/Audition merit list as determined by the Music Department of the college.
- HSSLC passed in any stream.

**Admission Fees:**

- It includes three months tuition fees and for hosteller's hostel admission fee includes Electricity and Room rent for three months at the time of Admission.
- Social security of Rs. 100 is realized every academic year at the time of admission and is included in the first installment. This amount covers the students for any eventuality while studying in Patkai. A student may receive Rs. 10,000 for accidental case if the treatment goes beyond Rs. 10,000 and Rs. 15,000 in case of Death.
- NU Enrolment fee/Registration Fees payable as per NU guidelines are included in the admission fee.
- Security Deposit of Rs. 3,000/-a onetime payment is included in the Admission a fee which is refundable on graduation or leaving the college.
- Uniform fees are payable separately.
- Mess fees are payable separately on monthly basis.

***N.B: Fees once paid will not be refunded after 15 days of class commencement except in case of Health issue. Refund of fees shall be made leaving aside the annual fees in case of admission withdrawal before the commencement of class. 50% of the refundable fees shall be granted within 15 days of class Commencement. The college and hostel fees for the Semester must be paid in full in the event of expulsion or cessation of studies apart from Health Issue.***

- *Monthly Mess fee of Rs. 2000/- per month shall be paid on or before 15<sup>th</sup> of every month. Late payment will incur a late fine of Rs. 20/- per day.* Mess fee for the academic session need to be cleared irrespective of whether he/she eats from the mess. In-case of any health issue, fee exemption/reduction will be effected only on the production of medical certificate.
- In-case the college working day ends by the 15<sup>th</sup> of a month, then only 50% of the monthly mess Fee will be realized. Any Hosteller staying beyond the 15<sup>th</sup> of a month will have to pay the mess fees in full.
- Late arrival after the hostel and college reopens does not allow any reduction in the monthly hostel fee since it is solely based on the working days of the college and every hosteller is expected to be in the hostel from the time of the re-opening. In case of any reduction in mess fee due to cancellation of classes then the discounted mess fee will be communicated to all the students.
- Mess fees shall increase by Rs. 100/- every academic year which is liable to increase further without prior information if situation arises.
- Hostel admission fees paid are not refundable. However, if failure to report due to the pandemic room rent and electricity charges may be considered for refund subject to the management decision.
