IQAC Meeting Minutes

Madam Akangsenla, the chairperson of the day welcomed the members and invited Dr. Vivee for the invocation prayer.

The chairperson gave time for short speeches to the Principal, Vice Principal and Controller of Examinations.

1. Dr. Thepfüvilie Pierü the Principal, in his opening remark opined the importance of having regular faculty meetings; however, he regretted that it wasn't possible this time due to the prevailing pandemic situation. He generously lauded the tireless effort of the exam section headed by Mr. Samuel controller of examinations for the smooth conduct of examinations with all preparedness. He also expressed satisfaction and appreciated the contribution of all the faculties in the entire academic exercise during these hard times.

He observed that, in view of the NAAC's fourth assessment due in the month of January 2021, the college has much to do. He pointed out that the college has made much progress vertically, however, horizontal growth was not much visible.

He stressed on the importance of keeping data available so as to enable the assessment team easy access to all information of for a good assessment. He concluded with a request to all the faculties to continue working hard and be at their toes in realizing the goal of the college.

2. Miss Angel, the Vice Principal, addressing the members started her speech in a positive note, inviting the members to join her in clapping for ourselves for the exceptionally good works done. She then, straight away highlighted the challenges ahead for NAAC report preparation during this fourth cycle of assessment. The New challenge is that, reports have to be uploaded online after which the NAAC team could call up anyone to verify facts and information provided in the report.

The HODs are alerted of the importance of being prepared with PowerPoint presentations of the departmental activities. Minute records of all activities are expected to be kept with proof in the form of pictures, videos and other means of documentations. Inter as well as intra class/department programmes and competitions (reports) may also be authentically kept for reporting purpose.

She concluded with a note of sincere appreciation to the three members deeply involved in the exercise of this herculean task of NAAC report preparation.
