Institutional strategies for mobilization of funds

The College is a non profiteering institute providing a wide range of courses and cultural events in the field of education. It is governed by the BOT appointed by the sponsoring body namely the NBCC and MBC. The College has received sponsorship from the NBCC, MBC, and Overseas Funding Agencies in the past, and presently, the UGC and NEC are major sponsoring agencies.

The fees collected from the students cover the basic operating costs. However, the college relies on the grant received from UGC, State Govt., and NEC for development of educational infrastructure/facilities. The source of income is given below.

Resource Mobilization:

1. Collection of Fees from the students.
2. Donation from well-wishers: With the passage of time the donation from well-wishers has reduced tremendously. In the initial stage the churches from Nagaland and Manipur has been the sponsors also from the foreign aid.
3. Grants from NEC: Under this grant the College has received for construction of MSSM Building and Girls' Hostel.
4. Grant-in-aid from the State Government: Every year the State Government gives an amount of ` . 200000/- as an assistance towards Faculty Salary
5. Grants from UGC for various developmental activities and upgradation of educational facility. Some of the different heads re: UGC Autonomous College grant; UGC College with Potential for Excellence grant; UGC Seminars and workshop, Minor research grant; UGC Women hostel and Boys Hostel building grant; UGC Outdoor/Indoor sports grant; UGC DDU Kaushal College Grant; UGC BSR Grant; UGC Teachers Fellowship Grant; UGC HRE Grant; UGC GDA Grant
