

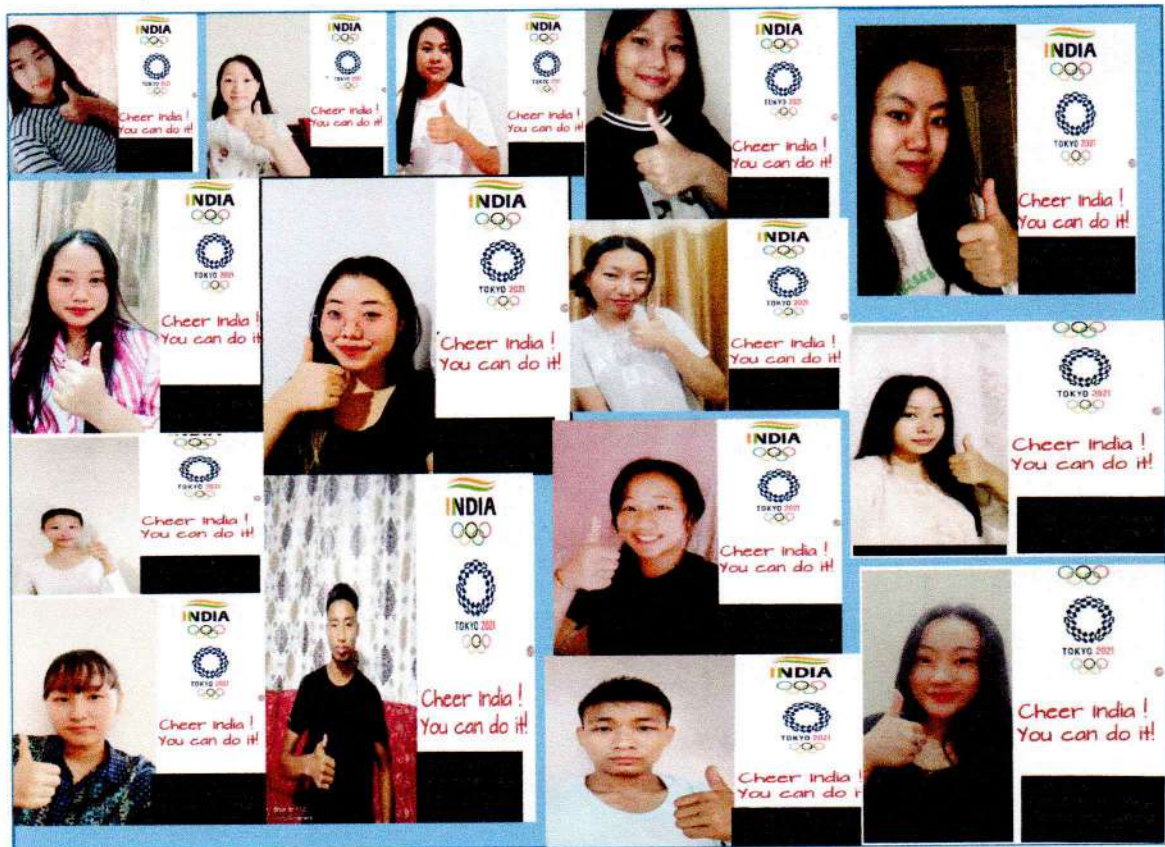

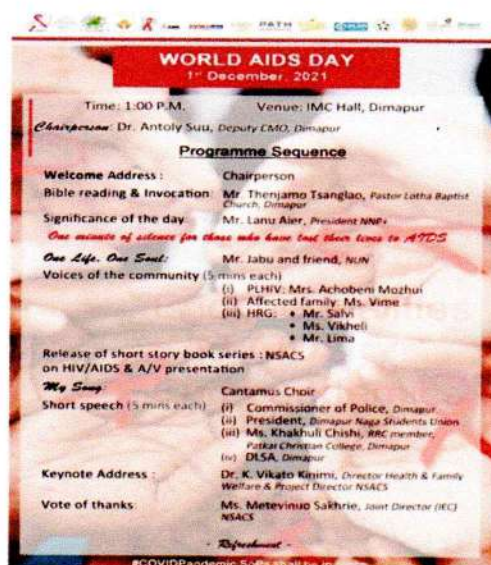

Slogan Competition to commemorate National Youth Day


