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
Inter-departmental talk – Department of English and Mass Communications

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
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Workshop on Unleashing Creativity



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

Advocate Apila Sangtam, Gauhati High Court, Kohima Bench as guest speaker deliberated on different types of violence such as homicide, assault, robbery and rape, stated a press release issued by the PCC.

'Nothing comes out good of violence', Sangtam stressed. She discussed four types of domestic violence; physical violence, sexual violence, verbal and emotional violence and economic violence and explained the procedures to file a domestic violence case. She shared a detail insight on Domestic Violence Act, 2005 and urged the students to be active agents in spreading awareness against domestic violence.

Dr Wojanbeni Yanthan, Assistant Professor, Department of Philosophy, PCC in her introductory remark stated that for any kind of change to take place there has to be a shift in our perception, for any kind of shift to take place in our perception we have to give time to produce the value.

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
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CHORAL NIGHT - An outreach program

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The Department of Mass Communication, Patkai Christian College (Autonomous) organised a workshop on 'Matrix of Just Peace' with Dr Aküm Longchari, peace and conflict activist and editor of The Morung Express, as resource person on October 13, 2023.

During the day-long workshop, Dr Longchari engaged the students in several exercises as he broke down concepts of conflict, power, how it manifests in society, peace, justice, and Just Peace, an update from the college stated.

He pointed out that most nation-states approach peace from a security perspective and so there is a lot of investment in defence and law enforcement whereas there is little investment in peace studies. "If there is a need to approach peace from a security perspective, it should be from a human security perspective," he asserted.

On understanding power, he demonstrated with an exercise its structure and dynamics and shared that power can be of three types- over people, within people, with people. It is important to know who wields power in order to understand the structure and dynamics, he said, further noting those at the top of the structure try to maintain their positions, while those at the bottom can be lulled into acceptance.

On the mechanisms of power, Dr Longchari shared that it should undergo a process, contending that it becomes an imposition devoid of a process. He added that if power changes hands, without changing the structure, the status quo remains.

In another exercise, he demonstrated how easily a group of people or community can be divided by the 'powers that be.' At times, it can be executed via small privileges here and there, he said. The 'divide and rule' has now transcended to 'define and rule,' he insisted.

On the effects of conflict, Dr Longchari viewed that conflict affects four dimensions of lifepersonal, relational, structures and culture. When there is a conflict, it changes the person, their relationships, existing structures and their attitudes and behaviours, he explained. Accordingly, it is easy to strip people of their 'humanity' during a conflict, he said. "The consequence of conflict is dehumanisation," he added.

On achieving Just Peace, Dr Longchari demonstrated through an exercise that Truth, Mercy, Justice and Peace should be the anchor points for reconciliation. He said that the point where Truth, Mercy, Justice and Peace meet is the start of genuine reconciliation. These concepts cannot work in isolation.

Citing examples of World War II, East Timor and post- Apartheid South Africa, he illustrated how devoid of these anchor points, processes to find justice or peace did not result in genuine reconciliation.

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Skill Development Training Program on Hand Made Paper and Pulp



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Workshop on Creative Direction

The Department of Mass Communication, Patkai Christian College organised a workshop on creative direction at Mass Comm studio, PCC on October 21, 2023.

Three public service announcement videos made by the third year Mass Communication students were released during the workshop in presence of Tiakumzuk Aier, Director, Dreamz Unlimited as the resource person.

The short videos titled 'Lulu', 'Social media a trap house' and 'Human Trafficking' is part of an extension activity of the department to create awareness in the society on pressing issues and concerns.

Following the screening, Aier gave feedbacks and pointed out the areas which require attention for their future projects. He also shared the journey of Dreamz Unlimited and his experience in film making and direction. Filmmaking needs patience and passion and to bring a story to the people one needs to be open to learning and being observant of the things happening around. Aier said that as filmmaker and director, one need to spend time writing a good script. "Let the script be the hero," he impressed.

Aier also highlighted the common mistakes amateur filmmakers make of which he explained about weak story, bad sound, poor casting choices, poor lighting, generic music, shots without purpose etc.

The biggest challenge in filmmaking is funding and the platform to screen the films that can aid in investment returns, to which he said OTT apps can act as a major boost.

Sunep, actor, member of Dreamz Unlimited spoke on acting and emphasized that an actor should understand the story while reading the script and not just limit to their own dialogues but also of the co-actors to keep the flow and tempo of the script.

Earlier, Neilevono Vüprü, Dean of Social Sciences, PCC in her speech stated that the trait which makes an individual different from the other is their 'Power of Creativity'. She expressed hope that the workshop would spark and ignite creativity among the students. She urged the students to shed off laziness and idleness, and encouraged them to be confident, consistent, disciplined and to challenge the self and make use of the opportunities given.

The session started off with the welcome address by Dr Dakter Esse Jamir, Head of Department, Mass Communication, invocation by Khakuli Chishi and concluded with vote of thanks by Motsuthung Ovung. Eriwe Kapfo was the compere for the day.



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

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
Workshop on 'The art of Film Documentation'

After her talk, there was a short Q&A session and the program concluded with a vote of thanks from Mr Sopei Rungsung, Assistant Professor.





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
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Hands-on Skill Training on Solid Waste Management

The Department of Chemistry, PCC collaborated with Kuda Village Waste Management Committees under Kuda Village Council and conducted a One Day Hands-on Skill Training on Solid Waste Management on April 24th, 2024 at the Kuda Village Waste Processing Facility, Dimapur. A total of 17 participants attended the training which included 14 students and 3 faculty members – Dr.T.Moaienla, Dr. Bendangsenla and Dr. Merangmenla. The management in-charge, Shri Kelhusesi Rino, a retired mining engineer gave a brief introduction on their processing facility and demonstrated the working of rotary waste segregator, bailing machine, glass and thermocol crusher along with up-cycling and down-cycling of plastic waste. The students made waterproof brooms out of plastic bottles by cutting bottles using bottle cutters which can also be an alternative of binding strings for farms. Concrete blocks were made from shredded thermocol and glass bottles alongwith some amount of cement which according to Shri Kelhusesi, was found to be more stable and provides more cooling than the commonly used concrete blocks. The machines and equipments used are all custom-made-locally maintaining their functionality to require energy to the minimum.

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
Masterclass on Studio Lighting with Shuk Shishak

The Department of Mass Communication organised a Masterclass on Studio Lighting with Shuk Shishak, a Dimapur-based professional photographer, at the Social Science Conference Room on Friday, May 3, 2024.

Shishak highlighted the basic concepts of the workings of a camera before going on to demonstrate the various types of lighting techniques used in photography viz., backlight, soft light, hard light, rim light, butterfly lighting, Rembrandt lighting etc. He also mentioned the various pros and cons of using each technique.

In the Q&A session, the resource person was questioned on the common mistakes that beginners make, and his response was flat lighting. This he said is a type of illumination which originates directly on the front side of the object.

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

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
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Annual Spring Concert and 10th Anniversary Concert
