Report on Fogging drive at Patkai Christian College campus, 05/10/2023.

In response to the outbreak of the vector-borne disease **Dengue**, the Department of Health and Family Welfare, under the establishment of The Chief Medical Officer, Dimapur District, Government of Nagaland, organized a fogging drive at Patkai Christian College campus on 5th October 2023. This initiative aimed to control and reduce the risk of dengue transmission among students, faculty, and staff. It also raised awareness about the importance of maintaining a mosquito-free environment.

The fogging was carried out across identified high-risk areas including the children park, playgrounds, areas around the residential quarters, hostels, academic and administrative buildings, stagnant water bodies, water tanks, and shaded areas.

Being a residential college, the fogging drive carried out by the department was an essential step in preventing the spread of dengue within the college campus. While the immediate results were effective, continued efforts are required to ensure the safety and health of students and staff. The government's proactive approach to tackling mosquito-borne diseases reflects its commitment to public health and wellness.
