Important General Instructions

All students are hereby informed that the following rules and regulations will be strictly enforced during the upcoming Mid-Term Examinations. Please read these guidelines carefully to ensure a smooth and fair examination process.

- 1. Mandatory Documents for Entry:** All students must wear their valid college ID card visibly around their neck while on the examination premises. This is mandatory for entry through the gate. Failure to comply will result in access being denied.
- 2. Punctuality and Hall Entry**
Students must arrive at the examination hall on time. **Entry will not be permitted 10 minutes after the examination has commenced.**
- 3. Electronic Devices**
All mobile phones, smartwatches, and any other electronic communication devices are strictly prohibited.
 - **Procedure:** Devices must be switched off and handed over to the invigilator **before** the start of the exam.
 - **Confiscation:** Any student found using such a device during the examination will have it immediately confiscated, and will face disciplinary action.
- 4. Late Arrival**
Late arrival will only be accommodated for day scholars who experience a documented delay with the official college transport. **All other reasons for tardiness will not be accepted,** and entry will be denied.
- 5. Admission**
Only students who have taken their admission for the current academic session are eligible to sit for the examinations. Non-admitted students taking will be nullified as and when detected.
- 6. Seating Arrangements**
Students must sit only in their assigned seats as per the official seating plan. Any confusion regarding room or seat allocation must be brought to the attention of an examination official **immediately.**
- 7. Early Departure**
Students are not allowed to leave the examination hall under any circumstances within the **first 30 minutes** of the examination.

Non-compliance with any of these guidelines will result in disciplinary action.
