Report of Awareness Programme on Electronic Waste Organized by Eco Club, Patkai Christian College (Autonomous)

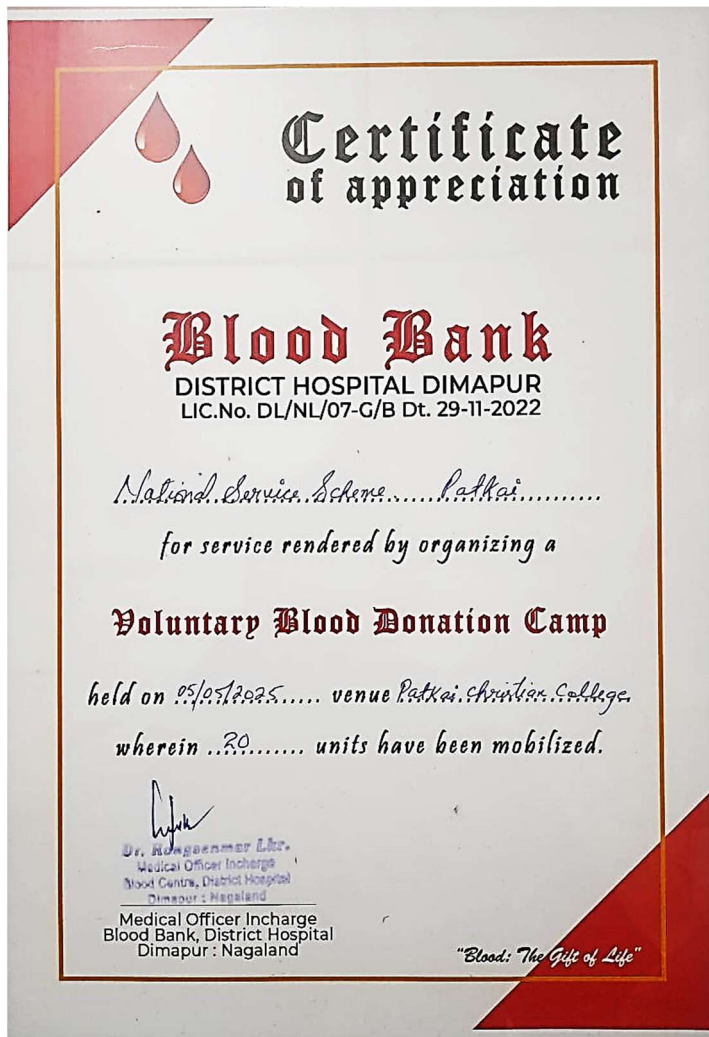

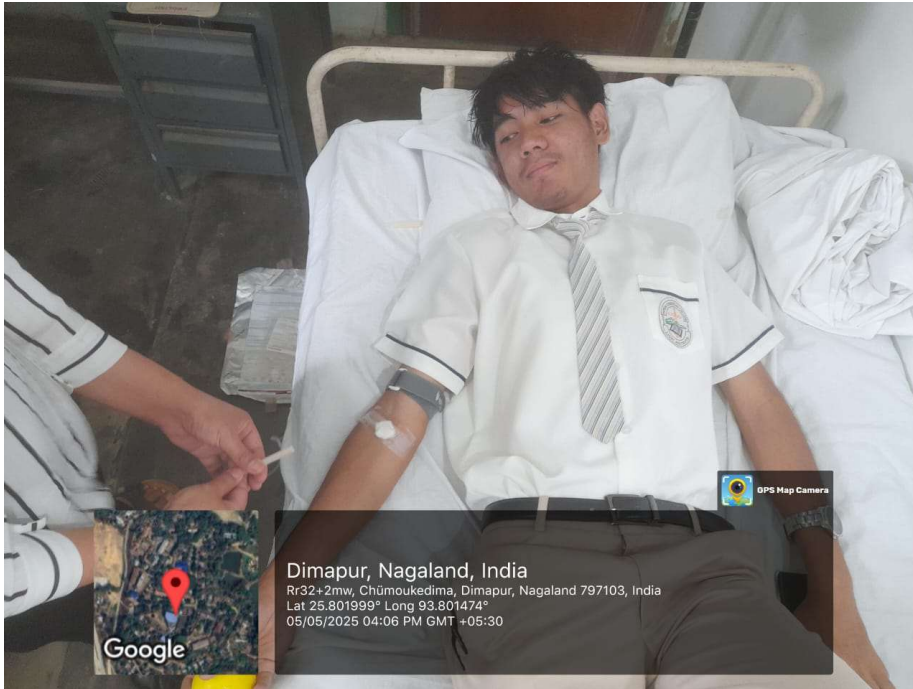

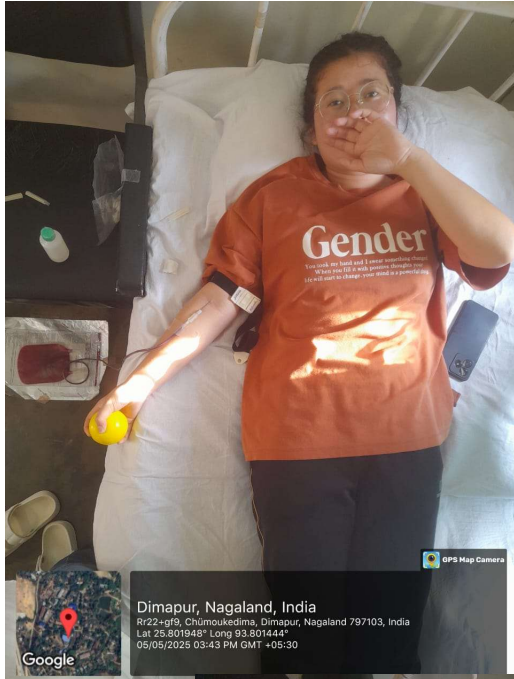
