On 28th September 2024, the under graduate classes of 3rd Semester and 5th semester students, consisting of 10 in number, were taken to Rubber Plantation and Processing Unit at Chumoukedima, Nagaland which is about 5 km away from Patkai Christian college campus.

The students were accompanied by three faculty members of the Department, namely Mr. Amay Angami, Dr. Thejanuo Rhetso and Mrs. Avono Savino.

Rubber tapping is usually most ideal in the early morning hours, so the group left for the plantation area and processing unit at 6am for observation and for first hand experience.

The owner Mr. Razouvotuo Chatsu welcomed the group and as he himself is a seasoned rubber farmer, explained in detail about nursery management, ideal time for transplanting, method of weeding and care, tapping process and processing of the same, such as coagulation, rolling, drying, fumigation etc..

He also encouraged the students to look beyond conventional careers, and explained about the cost and benefit of cultivation and sale of the produce.

Even shared about the challenges faced by rubber farmers.

Students benefitted from the exposure trip immensely.

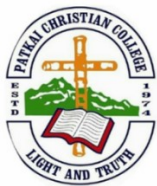

Overview of the Workshop

The session begins with words of appreciation from the college Principal Dr. Thepfüvilie Pieru. He thanked the resource person Dr. Mechuselie Kehie for his presence and congratulated Dr. Kensibo Pamai and his team for organizing such kind of workshop in the college. He also acknowledges the DBT for the funds provided towards the development of the science students and the college in general.

Abstract of the Technical Session -I: How to write a good research proposal.

Research is a systematic process of gathering, analysing, and interpreting data to create new knowledge or use existing knowledge in new ways. Research is basically categorised into four categories i. Basics ii. Applied iii. Descriptive iv. Analytical Research. Research proposal writing is crucial to secure a research project. A research proposal is a structured document that outlines what you plan to research, why it is important, and how you will accomplish it. The purpose of research proposal is to convince readers that your project is significant, feasible, and worth funding or support. The core elements of a research proposal generally include; title, abstract, introduction, literature review, objectives, methodology, significance of the study, expected outcome, timeline, budget, references/bibliography.



DBT-SPONSORED WORKSHOP ON RESEARCH PROPOSAL WRITING AND FUNDING STRATEGIES

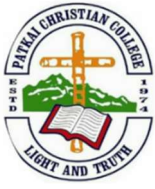

Resonating Stories: 4th Patkai Campus Film Festival goes Beyond Lights, Camera & Action



President of the Film Association of Nagaland Yapangnaro Longkumer addresses the inaugural day of the 3-day Campus Film Festival 4.0 organised by the Department of Mass Communication, Patkai Christian College (Autonomous) on October 28.

The collaborative nature of filmmaking and the importance of a story in driving a film forward were underscored as the 4th edition of the 3-day Campus Film Festival premiered today at the Bundrock Chapel Auditorium, Patkai Christian College (PCC) Autonomous.

In celebration of the college's 50th anniversary, the festival organised by the Department of Mass Communication is marked as the Golden Jubilee edition 4.0, and held under the theme "Beyond Lights, Camera, Action: Resonating Stories."

Speaking at the inaugural event, Guest of Honour and President of the Film Association of Nagaland (FAN), Yapangnaro Longkumer, noted that today's students possess greater skills and access to diverse platforms and storytelling methods.

She highlighted the importance of story in filmmaking, stating that while lights, camera, and action are essential, the crux of any film is its story.

"It is the story that propels you to make a film. It is the story that takes you forward," she remarked.

Engaging the audience in a mental exercise, she noted that while a setting or frame may be similar, varying interpretations bring diverse stories to life.

Longkumer also described how a concept transforms from narration to a written script and ultimately into a film, emphasising the hard work involved in filmmaking.

She shared an anecdote about *Laapataa Ladies*, recently chosen as India's official entry to the Oscars for Best International Feature, to underscore the collaborative aspects of filmmaking.

The film's original writer, Biplab Goswami, who was a colleague of hers, conceptualised the story in 2018. His script won second place in a national screenwriting competition, where actor and producer Aamir Khan, a jury member, showed interest in adapting it and wanted his then-wife, Kiran Rao, to direct.

However, Goswami initially intended to direct the project himself and sought producers independently, yet faced challenges as a new director in securing funding.

Ultimately, he returned to collaborate with Khan, who came on board as a producer. Though he eventually had to entrust the direction to another, this collaboration has brought him significant recognition, as he now moves towards the Oscars and receives multiple writing offers, Longkumer noted.

Thus, she stressed the collaborative nature of filmmaking, explaining that while someone may write a story, it often requires another director who may be more suited to bring it to life.

Market forces, especially funding, frequently influence these decisions. “This is what happens in filmmaking,” she said. “It’s a collaborative effort.”

To this end, Longkumer expressed her delight in seeing students and faculty working together over the years to successfully organise the festival, and she wished the current edition every success.

Giving a curtain-raiser, Wan-o Nangmung Yanlem, who along with Yomge Jilen are the festival directors, shared that since its inception in 2018, the festival has become an annual college event.

She noted that the festival serves as a platform “where small and even big filmmakers showcase their talents, where stories transcend boundaries, and where the magic of films brings us closer.”

Each film screened, Yanlem noted, reflects a unique perspective, with this year’s selection resonating with the theme “Lights, Camera, Action: Resonating Stories.”

She invited everyone to immerse themselves in the art of filmmaking and be inspired by the work of directors, writers, actors, and technical teams who have poured their heart and soul into each frame.

Earlier, Patkai Principal Dr Thepfüvilie Pierü commended the Department of Mass Communication for organising the festival through teamwork for the fourth time.

Quoting John C Maxwell, he highlighted teamwork principles like the Law of Significance, the Law of the Big Picture, the Law of the Catalyst, and the Law of Bad Apple.

Meanwhile, PCC Dean of Social Sciences, Neilevono Vupru, announced the winners of the short film contest organised to mark Patkai’s Golden Jubilee, followed by a screening of the winning film.

The entries included submissions from across India.

The short film contest winner was Who, directed by Verte Nuh, with Aditya Modal’s Redacted receiving the first consolation prize.

Two second consolation prizes were awarded to Kasadaru, directed by Ravichandran, and The Weight of Silence, directed by The Tetso Drama Club.

In addition to a diverse line-up of local, national, and international films, the festival includes a special screening for children on October 29.

Apex Motors, Hunky Dory, NICSE, and The King Chilli are the festival’s main sponsors, while The Morung Express and We the Nagas serve as print and digital partners, respectively.

The BSc and MSc students from Patkai Christian College (Autonomous), Chümoukedima-Seithekema visited the Central Institute of Horticulture, Medziphema as part of their educational field trip.

Objective of the Visit

- To learn hands on the propagation techniques and green house cultivation of crops
- To explore the research and development initiatives undertaken by the institute
- To gain insights into plant breeding, pest management and irrigation technologies
- To interact with experts

Visit overview

The students were warmly received by the staff of the Central Institute of Horticulture, Medziphema. The students were taken on a guided tour of the institute’s facilities which included the greenhouses, nursery and propagation units, pest management units and post-harvest management unit.

The students learned about controlled-environment farming, and how different plant varieties are propagated and grown. The nursery provided a hands-on demonstration of plant propagation techniques including grafting, cuttings and seed propagation. The students gained insights on the innovative techniques of CIH in Improving the quality and shelf life of harvested crop. The experts demonstrated the methods of sorting, packaging and storage emphasizing the importance of minimizing post-harvest losses.

Through this exposure programme students are able to understand the subjects like **Nursery Management (SBOT 101); Floriculture (SEC-1); Plant Breeding (BOT 251); and Plant Breeding and Plant Tissue Culture (BOT 642).**

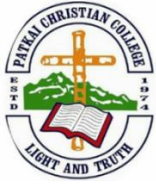

Report on Industrial Visit to Angami Plywood Factory, Tenyiphe, Chumoukedima, Nagaland, India

The BSc and MSc students from Patkai Christian College (Autonomous), Chümoukedima-Seithekema visited the Angami Plywood Factory, Tenyiphe, Chumoukedima, Nagaland, India as part of their educational field trip.

Objective of the Visit

- To observe the raw material processing of wood into plywood
- To identify the tree species used for plywood production
- To examine the sustainability practices of the factory in terms of sourcing raw materials.

Visit overview

The students were warmly received by the staff of the Angami Plywood Factory, Tenyiphe, Chumoukedima, Nagaland, India. The students were taken on a guided tour. The factory sourced its raw materials primarily from softwoods although hardwoods species were utilized for specialised plywood. The factory explained their commitment in sourcing wood from certified sustainable forests as set by Nagaland Forest Department. The timbers are cut into logs, debarked and sliced into thin veneers. These veneers are bonded together using adhesives to create multiple-layered plywood panels. The factory employed systems to recycle the waste product such as wood chips and saw dust are used as fuel for the factory's energy needs. The use of waste products helps reduce the ecological footprint of the factory and contributes to a circular economy.

The visit to the plywood factory provided valuable insight into the complex process of turning raw wood into plywood and highlighted several environmental and sustainability considerations as a botanist. Expanding reforestation efforts to ensure balance between industrial and environmental conservation.

Through this exposure program the students are able to understand the subjects like **Economic Botany (BOT 132) and Phytogeography, Biodiversity and Economic Botany (BOT 641)**.

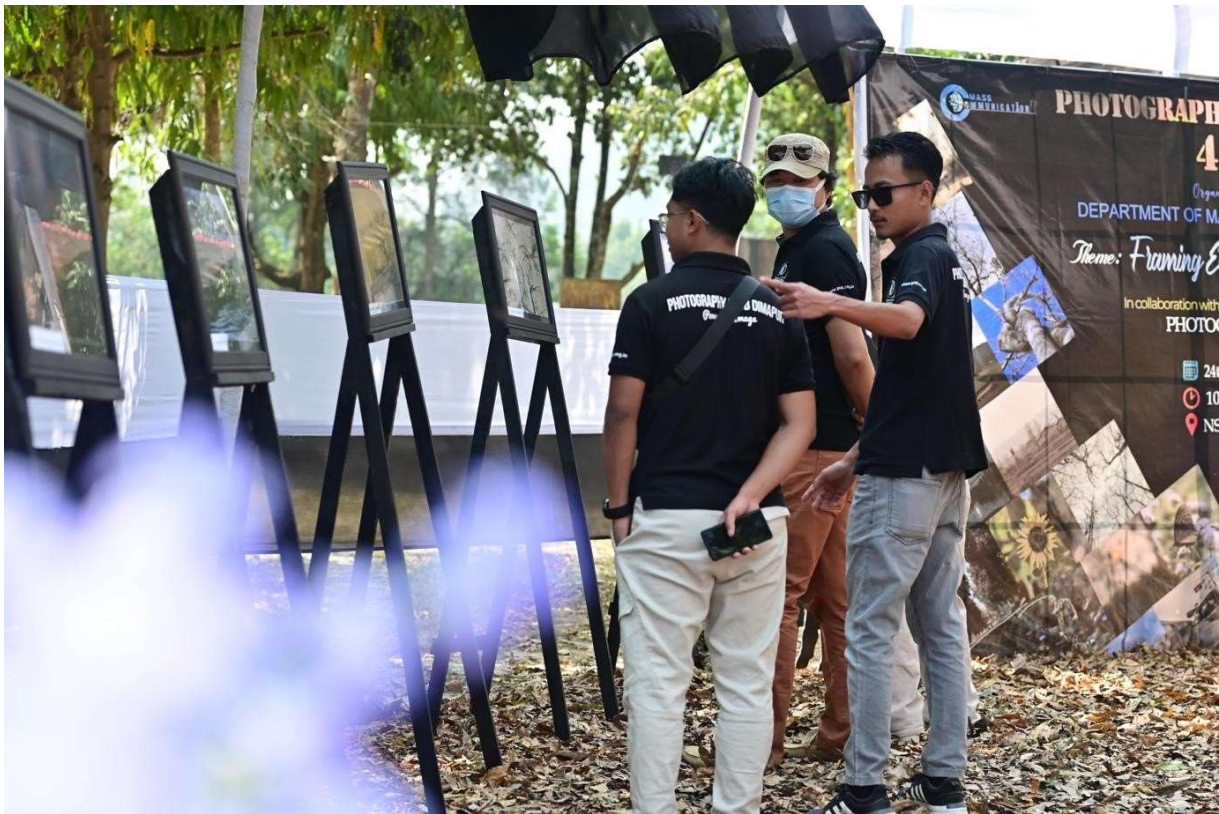
