Activity Report: March 2025 - August 2025

1. Economic and Sustainability Initiatives

The quarter commenced with crucial activities related to the Alumni Fishery Project, ensuring its continued success and future viability.

1.1. Alumni Fishery Fish Harvest Sale (13th March 2025): The annual fish harvest sale was successfully conducted on 13th March 2025. This highly anticipated event marks the culmination of the fishery cycle, providing high-quality produce to the college community and local residents. The sale achieved its projected targets, resulting in a substantial and reliable revenue stream for the AAPCC. The proceeds are earmarked for funding future alumni-led welfare schemes and infrastructure support projects within the college.

1.2. AAPCC Fishery Pond Renovation (27th March 2025): Following the successful harvest, the AAPCC organized a focused renovation drive on 27th March 2025.
