The 14th Academic Council Meeting of Patkai Christian College (Autonomous) was conducted on the 15th of July 2025 with Principal of the college as the Chairman. He welcomed the members, particularly the External Members namely, Prof. Pauline Alila, Dept. of Horticulture, SAS, NU and Prof. K. K. Jha, Dept. of Agricultural Extension Education, SAS, NU. Rev. Dr. Vichukho, the chaplain of the college pronounced the opening prayer to begin the business of the day.

The Heads of 15 Academic Departments (HODs) presented their proposed Four Years Under Graduate Programme (FYUGP) syllabus, following NEP2020 guidelines, prepared by the Board of Under Graduate Studies of the respective departments to the Academic Council for perusal and approval. Discussions and inputs suggested by the External Members.

1. **Economics** – Queries were raised on the Major and Minor papers having the same course title with different course code which was clarified by the concerned HOD. Clarification was also given on common pool papers.
2. **Education** – It will be good and look better if the break –up of credit hours for practical and theory components are indicated in the syllabus.
3. **History** – Research/dissertation paper of 12 credits was not mentioned in the syllabus. Every dept should offer research/dissertation paper in the 8th semester. The dept seems to have over-emphasized NE and Regional History in the syllabus which was questioned by the external whether there will be any short fall when it comes to competitive examinations. This was clarified by the HoD that this aspect was considered.
4. **Philosophy** – Public speaking as SEC paper should have practical components and not only as theory paper. Research/dissertation need to be included in the 8th semester.
5. **Mathematics** – Syllabus should have page nos. Testing of hypothesis is necessary for Mathematics. Practical components should be added. The HOD informed that most of the syllabus is in line with CBCS with some additions added to all the papers.
6. **Physics** – Practicals should be mentioned right after the theory papers and not after the suggested readings.
7. **Zoology** – Practical for poultry farming is feasible for the students. 1 or 2 students can take care of a few broiler chickens for practical hands on training. Pisciculture and apiculture, though in the syllabus, may be more difficult to handle.

The FYUGP syllabi presented by the HODs of Economics, Education, English, History, Mass Communication, Philosophy, Political Science, Commerce, Botany, Chemistry, Geology, Mathematics, Physics, Zoology and BCA were approved. The revised 2 years Post Graduate syllabi of Botany and Zoology departments were also approved.

Prof. K. K. Jha


- a) Gave a glowing comment on the work and dedication put forward by the teachers on the preparation and revision of the syllabi.


11th ACADEMIC COUNCIL: 3rd September 2016

NATIONAL CADET CORPS (NCC)

The NCC as an elective subject offers the students a package of selected subjects and disciplines, which are essential for the overall development of a person's character, personality and well-being in today's highly competitive world. Apart from imparting basic military trainings, the course offers several other disciplines such as personality development, leadership training, social service, disaster management, health and hygiene, life skills, adventure trainings, environmental awareness and human rights education. The department aims to produce technically trained and knowledgeable manpower in the field with interest and potential in scientific skills, thinking, communication, analytical writing, designing possible remedies and generating data base on local and national environmental issues that may have global significance.

The entire course curriculum is designed keeping in mind the need to create a human resource of highly organised, trained, disciplined and motivated youth, to provide leadership in all walks of life and always be available for the service of the society and nation at large.

'B' & 'C' certificate: After completion of 2 years and at least 1 camp cadet can appear for 'B' Certificate Examination and after completion of 3 years and at least 2 camps cadet can appear for 'C' Certificate Examination.

NCC is offered as an elective subject with 12 credit hours spread over 6 semesters and is open to all streams of undergraduate programmes.

CERTIFICATE COURSES

Certificate Course in Counselling offered by the department of Bible is for the U.G. students who are enrolled in the third semester. This is a practical and stimulating course introducing and preparing the students to understand the fundamentals of counselling, the modes of operation and how these tools can be applied in addressing the myriad social problems being faced in the society. Certificate in Applied Electronics and Computer Hardware

In the last few years, the use of electrical and electronic gadgets has increased tremendously. These gadgets are used for personal purpose or in educational and professional field. With this, the need for trained personnel for maintenance and repair of the gadgets has also increased.

The main objective of this course is to train the student in applied field of electronics and computer hardware along with undergraduate study. This course will train the students on how to install and manage household electrical wiring, basics of electronics such as amplifiers, battery chargers, inverters, computer hardware etc. Repairing of electronic devices used in scientific laboratories is also included in the course. The course is very potent for self-employment, employment in electrical and electronic farms, computer hardware as well as for personal purpose. The other details pertaining to this course may be had from the department.

Photography & Visual Communication

The objective of the course is to educate still photography practitioners within a larger framework of imaging studies, visual culture and new digital technologies. Students are exposed to different kinds of photography practices such as micro photography, street photography, photojournalism, advertising photography, industrial photography, science, lifestyle, documentary and research based photography.

Course Inputs:

The course is for 3 months duration and includes class-room theoretical sessions and hands on learning. The time given for the practical will be half of the duration of the course.

The BSc and MSc students from Patkai Christian College (Autonomous), Chümoukedima-Seithekema visited the Central Institute of Horticulture, Medziphema as part of their educational field trip.

Objective of the Visit

- To learn hands on the propagation techniques and green house cultivation of crops
- To explore the research and development initiatives undertaken by the institute
- To gain insights into plant breeding, pest management and irrigation technologies
- To interact with experts

Visit overview

The students were warmly received by the staff of the Central Institute of Horticulture, Medziphema. The students were taken on a guided tour of the institute’s facilities which included the greenhouses, nursery and propagation units, pest management units and post-harvest management unit.

The students learned about controlled-environment farming, and how different plant varieties are propagated and grown. The nursery provided a hands-on demonstration of plant propagation techniques including grafting, cuttings and seed propagation. The students gained insights on the innovative techniques of CIH in Improving the quality and shelf life of harvested crop. The experts demonstrated the methods of sorting, packaging and storage emphasizing the importance of minimizing post-harvest losses.

Through this exposure programme students are able to understand the subjects like **Nursery Management (SBOT 101); Floriculture (SEC-1); Plant Breeding (BOT 251); and Plant Breeding and Plant Tissue Culture (BOT 642).**

Report on Industrial Visit to Angami Plywood Factory, Tenyiphe, Chumoukedima, Nagaland, India

The BSc and MSc students from Patkai Christian College (Autonomous), Chümoukedima-Seithekema visited the Angami Plywood Factory, Tenyiphe, Chumoukedima, Nagaland, India as part of their educational field trip.

Objective of the Visit

- To observe the raw material processing of wood into plywood
- To identify the tree species used for plywood production
- To examine the sustainability practices of the factory in terms of sourcing raw materials.

Visit overview

The students were warmly received by the staff of the Angami Plywood Factory, Tenyiphe, Chumoukedima, Nagaland, India. The students were taken on a guided tour. The factory sourced its raw materials primarily from softwoods although hardwoods species were utilized for specialised plywood. The factory explained their commitment in sourcing wood from certified sustainable forests as set by Nagaland Forest Department. The timbers are cut into logs, debarked and sliced into thin veneers. These veneers are bonded together using adhesives to create multiple-layered plywood panels. The factory employed systems to recycle the waste product such as wood chips and saw dust are used as fuel for the factory's energy needs. The use of waste products helps reduce the ecological footprint of the factory and contributes to a circular economy.

The visit to the plywood factory provided valuable insight into the complex process of turning raw wood into plywood and highlighted several environmental and sustainability considerations as a botanist. Expanding reforestation efforts to ensure balance between industrial and environmental conservation.

Through this exposure program the students are able to understand the subjects like **Economic Botany (BOT 132) and Phytogeography, Biodiversity and Economic Botany (BOT 641).**
