Graduation Day Registration – Class of 2026

All Undergraduate (UG) and Postgraduate (PG) students of the **Class of 2026** are hereby informed that the Graduation Day will be held on **21 July 2026**. All graduating students are requested to take careful note of the following guidelines:

1. Eligibility for Registration

Students who have successfully fulfilled all degree requirements in the **May–June 2026 Semester End Examinations**, including those who have qualified through regular or repeat examinations, are eligible to register for the Graduation Day ceremony.

2. Registration Period

- **Registration Dates:** 9–15 July 2026
- No registration will be accepted after the closing date.
- Each graduating student may invite **up to two (2) parents/guardians** to attend the ceremony. The details of the invitees must be provided during registration.

3. Clearance of Dues

All outstanding college dues must be cleared **on or before 15 July 2026**. Only students who have cleared all dues will be permitted to participate in the Graduation Day ceremony.

4. Academic Gown

- **Collection:** 9–18 July 2026 from the **General Section Office**.
- **Dressing Room (Graduation Day):** Margaret Shishak School of Music Building.
- **Return of Gown:** All gowns must be returned immediately after the ceremony to the **Margaret Shishak School of Music Office**.

5. Clearance and Security Deposit Refund

- Security Deposit refunds are applicable **only to graduating students**.
- Refunds may be claimed **from 16–18 July 2026** during gown collection.
- Students must clear all outstanding dues and submit the duly completed **Clearance Form** before claiming the Security Deposit refund.

6. Collection of Certificates and Mark Sheets

Students who are unable to attend the Graduation Day ceremony may collect their **Degree Certificate and Mark Sheet** from the **General Section Office** with effect from **27 July 2026**.

All graduating students are advised to complete the registration and other formalities within the stipulated dates.
