12th ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 10/05/2019

The meeting was chaired by Principal Mr. Hüsazü Epao and Dr. Vivee Peseye said the invocation prayer.

In his welcome address, he introduced the External members Dr. Sedevi Angami from Industrial Sector (CIHSR) and Prof. Lungsang Zeliang, N.U representative. He then introduced the Head of Departments present in the meeting.

He informed the house that Patkai had implemented the CBCS (Choice Based Credit System) in response to UGC directive in 2015, the syllabus for which was approved in the 11th Academic Council in 2016. On completion of 3 years the syllabus was reviewed with minor changes and uniformity in course distribution. Hence, all the HODs were instructed to look into it and present the same for approval.

The Principal informed that the college had applied for B Voc program in Mass Communication to the UGC and it was approved in August, 2018. The syllabus was prepared by Dr. Dakter and after approval from BUGS, the same is presented for approval in the Academic Council. The Principal also mentioned that the College plans to take it up and continue beyond UGC plan.

PROCEEDINGS OF THE MEETING.

1. **Economics:** Mr. Jonathan presented the syllabi for Economics department. He informed that they had re-arranged the Course Content of each Course into five uniform units by adding one unit each in ECO 121 & ECO 321. Corrections were also made in ECO 162 and replaced Dissertation from ECO262 with Environmental Economics. The syllabus was approved by the members.
2. **Education:** Mrs. Ase Z Pongshi presented the syllabus for Education department. She informed that in EDN 251 Unit 5 – Acharya Vinoba Bhave's philosophy is replaced by Swami Vivekananda's philosophy. She also mentioned that the Course Content for SEC Course was re-arranged into 3 units as suggested by the SENATUS. Prof. Lungsang suggested that some more topics can be included in EDN 251. After which the syllabi was approved.
3. **English:** Mrs. Akangsenla presented the syllabi for the department of English (UG), she informed that they had re-arranged the course content of each Course into 5 uniform units and SEC course into 3 units. There was change in DSE II course from Research methodology to Literary criticism. The syllabus was approved by the members.
4. **Philosophy:** Dr. Wojanbeni, HOD of the department presented the syllabi. She informed that they have highlighted the sub topics of each course and re-arranged course content of SEC into 3 units as suggested by the SENATUS. The department also had made some changes by interchanging Project Work to PHI 262.
5. **Political Science:** Mr. Wetshele Thopi presented the syllabi for UG and PG Political Science. He informed that for UG, the course content was re-arranged into 5 uniform units except for SEC which was arranged into 3 uniform units. He also informed that they had interchanged the course content of PSC 111 and PSC 251 – Human Rights. For the PG syllabus, the BOS had met and approved the syllabus. The syllabus was approved with appreciation.
6. **Commerce:** Ms. Hüsätülü presented the syllabus for Commerce department. She mentioned that they had re-arranged the course content of each course into 5 uniform units with addition of few topics in COM 251. The SEC course content was re-arranged into 3 units. The members approved the syllabi.

7. **Botany:** Mrs. Avono Savino presented the syllabi for Botany department. She informed that they had re-arranged the course content of each course into 5 uniform units except SEC which was re-arranged into 3 uniform units. Besides these, no other changes were made in the course content. The syllabus was approved by the members of the Council.
8. **Chemistry:** Mr. Oinam U-wang presented the syllabi for the department of Chemistry. He informed that they had re-arranged the course content of each course into 5 uniform units and the SEC course content into 3 uniform units. The other changes made in the Course include-
CHM252-Green chemistry is replaced by Industrial chemicals and Environment
CHM261-Research Methodology is replaced by Green Chemistry
CHM262-Dissertation is replaced by Spectroscopic Technique in chemistry.

The Chairman remarked that, for such major changes as in Chemistry Syllabi, the involvement of external BUGS members is necessary. However after much explanation the syllabus was approved.

9. **Geology:** Dr. T. Pieru presented the UG & PG syllabus for Geology for approval. He mentioned that minor changes were made in GEO 614 for PG and no changes were made in UG except re-arranging the course content into 5 uniform units and 3 units in SEC. The syllabus was approved by the member
10. **Zoology:** Dr. Sanjeeb Dey Baidya presented the syllabi for Zoology department for approval. He mentioned that some minor changes were made in ZOO 121, ZOO 122 and ZOO 321. The Course content of SEC was re-arranged into 3 uniform units as suggested by the SENATUS. Dr. Sedevi Angami suggested that for physiology and Biochemistry practicals, students can avail the facilities from CISHR. The syllabus was approved by the members.
11. **Computer Science:** Mr. Milan Singha presented the syllabi for BCA for approval. He mentioned that they have changed the 1st Semester Course into Computer Fundamentals.
12. **Music:** Dr. Vivee presented the syllabi for Music. She mentioned that MUS 352 – Introduction to Ethno music & Arts was changed into Ethnomusicology. She also mentioned that at present total credits earned by Music students in 4 years is 136 and so they have enhanced it to 140 credits by adding 1 Course in 6th Semester. MUS 262– Naga Music.
13. **Mass Communication:** Dr. Dakter Esse presented the syllabi for BVoc Mass Communication. She mentioned that the BOS comprising of 5 deliberated on the syllabi prepared by the department and few changes were made. Mass communication being skill paper has a total credit of 180. The members appreciated the efforts put by the HOD along with the external members and approved the syllabi.
