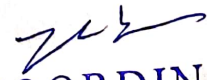
Proceedings and Resolutions

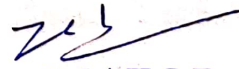
1. Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) - faculty promotion draft placed by the Principal

2. Faculty Development Programme on Generative AI: The Committee confirmed the programme titled "Generative AI and Teaching-Learning Practices in Higher Education" for Thursday, 29 January 2026 at 2:30 p.m. The Resource Person was confirmed as Dr. Tiatemsu Longkumer, Senior Lecturer, Department of Anthropology, Royal Thimphu College, Bhutan.

Recorded Objective of the Programme

The programme was intended to familiarise faculty members with Generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) and its emerging role in teaching-learning practices in higher education. It aimed to develop a foundational understanding of generative AI, promote pedagogically sound use of AI tools, and strengthen faculty capacity to integrate such tools into classroom instruction, assessment and academic writing.

1. Finalisation of the Strategic Plan (2024-2029) Progress Report for submission to the Board of Trustees

Proceedings and Resolutions

1. The Strategic Plan (2024-2029) Progress Report for the Academic Year 2025-2026 was tabled before the Committee. After consideration, the report was approved for onward submission to the Board of Trustees. The approved report is set out below.

A. Excel in Knowledge

- Goal 1 - Multidisciplinary courses and student exchange: The NEP-aligned UG and PG syllabi were completed and approved by the Academic Council on 15 July 2025, enabling the introduction of multidisciplinary courses across departments. Skill-based certificate initiatives included mushroom cultivation, soap production and vermicomposting; co-curricular participation through clubs, cultural programmes, NCC, NSS and literary activities continued; and short-term cultural exchange programmes with peer institutions in neighbouring states were being explored.
- Goal 2 - Faculty development: The College continued to promote faculty participation in seminars, workshops, FDPs and UGC orientation/refresher programmes. The report recorded 13 faculty participations during June 2025-May 2026 and 39 during June 2024-May 2025. Institutional FDPs included "Pedagogical Practices and Professional Ethics" (06 September 2025) and "Generative AI and Teaching-Learning Practices in Higher Education" (29 January 2026). Training and quality-standardisation initiatives were also being extended to administrative staff.
- Goal 3 - Research, innovation and community engagement: A Research Methodology course was integrated as a mandatory seventh-semester component under NEP 2020. The Research Core Committee finalised the College Research Policy and guidelines on 17 February 2026 after extensive deliberations. The feasibility of a phased part-time Ph.D. programme was under consideration. The Research Committee also organised a talk on "Emerging Trends in Research Publication" on 25 September 2025. The report recorded six research papers in notified Web of Science/Scopus/UGC CARE journals for 2025-2026, and eight such papers plus ten book chapters for 2024-2025.
- Goal 4 - Industry collaboration: The committee reported commitments from 15 organisations, including government and private-sector partners, for structured student internships. Partnerships cited included the Women Industrial Training Institute, Nagaland Bamboo

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Development Agency, National Institute of Electronics and Information Technology, Tata Motors, Westside, Vishal Megamart, Root on Roof, Progressive Motors and other local enterprises. The report also recorded the appointment of an IAPC Nodal Officer.

- Goal 5 - Infrastructure: Short-term attention was directed towards renovation of classroom and hostel facilities and improvement of water quality. Longer-term planning included classroom renovation, a conference room, a water project and campus road improvement.

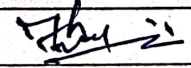
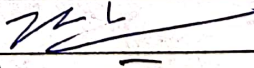
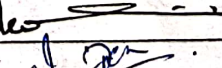
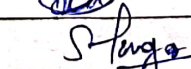
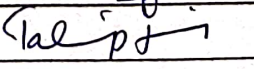
B. Formulate a Biblical Worldview

- Goal 6 - Integration of faith and academics: The "Dialogue on Integrating Faith and Academics" series, launched in October 2024, continued as an institutional initiative, with the Tuisem Shishak Annual Lecture identified as one such activity. Publication of the College's foundational educational philosophy on the institutional website was also under consideration.
- Goal 7 - Theological studies: The core team continued to revisit and refine the proposal and syllabi previously submitted to the Board for a formal theological course.
- Goal 8 - Spiritual outreach: The report noted that formal structuring and reporting of outreach programmes by the Spiritual Ministry remained pending and required acceleration.

C. Develop Critical Thinking Skills

- Goal 9 - Inquisitiveness, enquiry and debate: The designated committee continued work on an institutional foundational document intended to cultivate critical thinking and active engagement among faculty and students.
- Goal 10 - Community exposure through field trips: A framework for educational exposure was under preparation, including classification by duration and thematic focus. Departments were encouraged to connect educational field exposure with academic learning so as to link classroom theory with real-world phenomena and deepen student engagement.

Proceedings and Resolutions

1. Final Submission of AQAR 2024-2025: The Committee reviewed the AQAR 2024-2025 placed for final consideration, including the institutional data and information compiled for submission to the Directorate of Higher Education, Government of Nagaland. After discussion, the Committee approved the report for final submission, subject to incorporation of the corrections and clarifications agreed upon during the meeting. The IQAC was accordingly directed to complete the submission process and maintain the relevant supporting records as part of the College's quality-assurance documentation.
2. Field Work / Field Project: The Committee discussed the need for clear academic classification and documentation of field-based learning activities. It was resolved that where an activity is undertaken as part of the curriculum, course requirement or teaching-learning process, it shall be recorded as "Field Work" or "Field Project," as applicable, rather than being described merely as a "Field Trip." Such field-based activity shall clearly indicate its linkage with the concerned course/paper, the specific topic or unit to which it relates, and the relevant lesson plan or teaching plan. This linkage is to ensure that field-based learning is demonstrably academic, purposeful and integrated with the approved curriculum rather than being treated as an isolated excursion. The Committee approved this principle for adoption in future academic planning, departmental documentation and quality-assurance reporting.

Proceedings and Resolutions

1. Annual Review: The Committee reviewed the implementation of the IQAC Plan of Action and the follow-up measures taken during 2025-2026. It noted that regular meetings had been convened to review progress, departments had been followed up for timely compilation of AQAR-related data, and stakeholder feedback continued to be collected and used as an input for quality improvement. The key areas of achievement and action during the year were recorded as follows:

1. Enhancing Research Culture and Faculty Development

Faculty and research capacity were strengthened through the Workshop on "Pedagogical Practices and Professional Ethics" (06 September 2025) and the lecture on "Emerging Trends in Research Publication" (25 September 2025). Research methodology and ethics awareness were further supported through the GEO 3rd Lecture Series (27 August 2025), the seminar on "Knowing Responsibility: Indigenous Knowledge and the Ethics of Research" (19 March 2026), the IPR talk (12 February 2026), and inter-departmental academic talks held during the year.

2. Strengthening Student Employability and Skill Development

Entrepreneurship, apprenticeship and career-readiness initiatives were expanded through the World Entrepreneurship Day Workshop (21 August 2025), the PM-NAPS Apprenticeship Portal Awareness & Registration Drive (11 September 2025), the IBM SkillBuild Programme (03-04 November 2025) and the Career & Job Fair 2026 (27 March 2026). These were complemented by a Masterclass on Mutual Funds, Career Counselling Camp, Startup Awareness Workshop, Orientation Programme for Graduating Students, and sessions on legal, financial and soft-skills literacy.

3. Institutionalising Data-Driven Quality Assurance and Academic Practices

The IQAC continued to strengthen academic quality through faculty-development programmes, inter-departmental academic interactions and technology-enabled teaching initiatives, including the Workshop on Pedagogical Practices and Professional Ethics and the programme on Generative AI

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in Higher Education. Academic and administrative audit findings and NIRF-related data compilation continued to be maintained through IQAC records.

4. Promoting Community Engagement and Extension Activities

Outreach and awareness initiatives included the talk on "Journey as a Special Needs Parent (Down Syndrome)" (13 August 2025), the Mental Health Awareness Session (21 August 2025), International Women's Day and Mahila Jan Sunwai observances (11 March 2026), and sessions on Ambient Air Quality & Waste Management, E-waste Management and Farming with Nature. Safety and civic awareness were also addressed through the Workshop on Basic First Aid & Emergency Response and the One-Day Training on Disaster Management (23 February 2026).

5. Comprehensive Implementation of NEP 2020 and Skill-Based Education

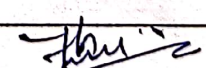
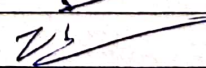
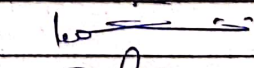
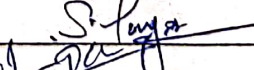
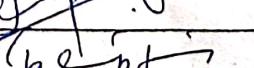
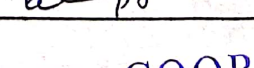
Practical and multidisciplinary skill training under NEP 2020 was advanced through Mushroom Culture Training (11 February 2026), the "Pickling Perfect" Hands-on Training (09 October 2025) and the Farming with Nature programme (06 October 2025), together with value-added activities such as the Film Festival, Photography Exhibition 5.0 and Cello and Art Workshops.

6. Phased Digital Capacity Building

Digital and AI readiness among faculty and students was supported through the talk on "Generative AI and Teaching-Learning Practices in Higher Education" (29 January 2026) and "AI and the Future: Skills, Tools and Challenges" (30 April 2026), advancing the IQAC's planned objective of technology-enabled and generative-AI-focused capacity building.

2. Stepping Down of Steering Committee Members: The Committee took note of the stepping down of Bendangsenla N. and Zhoto Tunyi from the IQAC Steering Committee. Their participation and contribution to the work of the Steering Committee during the period under review were placed on record with appreciation.
